- Must write a 500-word essay with application, see application for detailed instructions
(Note: Spelling and Grammar count)

INTERNSHIP REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be a meaningful work experience at competitive wage within the student's major
- Must have stated objectives and outcome
- Must be a minimum of 10 -14 weeks duration
- Must be with a corporate member of the Investment Casting Institute
